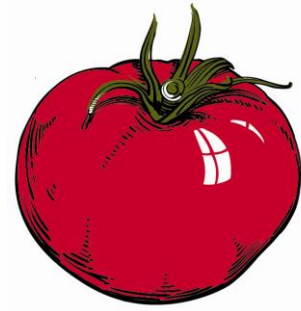


2010 Local Works Farmers' Market Rules & Vendor Contract



Location & Time

Saturdays 9AM to 1PM, Main Street, Bethlehem, NH
Thursdays 3PM to 7PM, Berlin, NH—exact location TBD

Registration Fees for the Season

FREE for WREN members
\$35 for the season which includes a WREN membership/renewal
\$20 Early Bird Special for New Farmers' Market Vendors
(before March 1st, 2010)

Weekly Fees

5% sales revenue will be collected from vendors at the end of each market day.

Site Selection

The Market Coordinator will assign sites based upon size requirements and/or specific vendor needs.

Every effort will be made to keep sites consistent from week to week.

Contact the Market Coordinator if you are unable to attend a market.

Set-Up

Vendors must be completely set up and ready to sell by the official opening of the market.

Sites should remain open until the close of the market.

Vendor sites must be cleaned and vacated within an hour after the official close of the market.

Vendors shall be responsible for their own waste disposal.

Acceptable Products for the Local Works Farmers' Market

Locally grown vegetables, herbs and fruits

Meats and cheeses grown or produced by vendor

Maple, honey, wool or other related farm products

Vendor made crafts (soaps, candles, quilts, wood carvings, etc)

Home baked goods (baked items, jams, jellies, pickles, etc.) with a Homestead

License.

There is to be no reselling of produce at the market. All produce must be from the vendor's own farm

must be pre-approved by the Market Coordinator and/or the Local Works Farmers' Market Committee.

Market Operations

The Market Coordinator is responsible for the successful and orderly operation of the market. Questions and issues are to be addressed to the Coordinator before or after the official hours of operation. To ensure a productive marketplace for both vendors and customers, there are to be no disputes at the market site. Formal complaints may be submitted in writing to The Farmers' market Committee, c/o WREN, P.O. Box 331, Bethlehem, NH 03574.

The Committee reserves the right to visit any vendor's business operation to authenticate that products are locally made or locally grown.

No soliciting by political or religious groups is permitted.

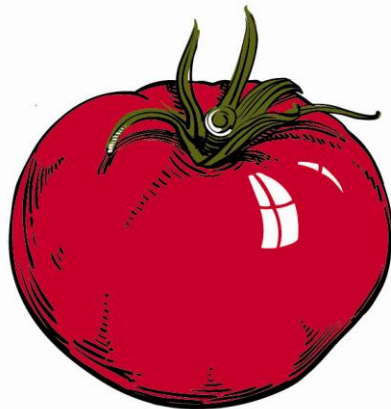
Vendor's children and/or pets must be supervised.

The Local Works Farmers' Market expects vendors to adhere to honest and ethical business practices. Illegal, fraudulent or dishonest practices are prohibited.

If a vendor fails to comply with the above rules, the Local Works Farmers' Market Committee reserves the right to cancel the vendor's participation in the market with no refund of fees.
